

# County-Level Overdose Mortality Report

Prepared by: The Drug Threat Analysis Group

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## Introduction

This report provides an analysis of national overdose mortality data across all counties in the United States. Drawing from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's Wide-ranging Online Data for Epidemiologic Research (CDC WONDER) system<sup>1</sup>, this analysis encompasses standardized mortality data that allows for consistent comparisons of overdose impacts across diverse geographic areas.

The county-level approach used in this report recognizes that drug overdose patterns and trends often manifest differently at the local level than they do in broader state or national contexts. Presenting data at the county level provides granular detail helpful for targeted intervention and resource allocation decisions. Each county's data is a reflection of the unique demographic, socioeconomic, and geographic factors that influence local overdose mortality patterns. This report was prepared by the Drug Threat Analysis Group (DTAG) to inform evidence-based decision-making and promote a unified, coordinated response to the overdose crisis across all levels of government and community involvement.

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## Methodology

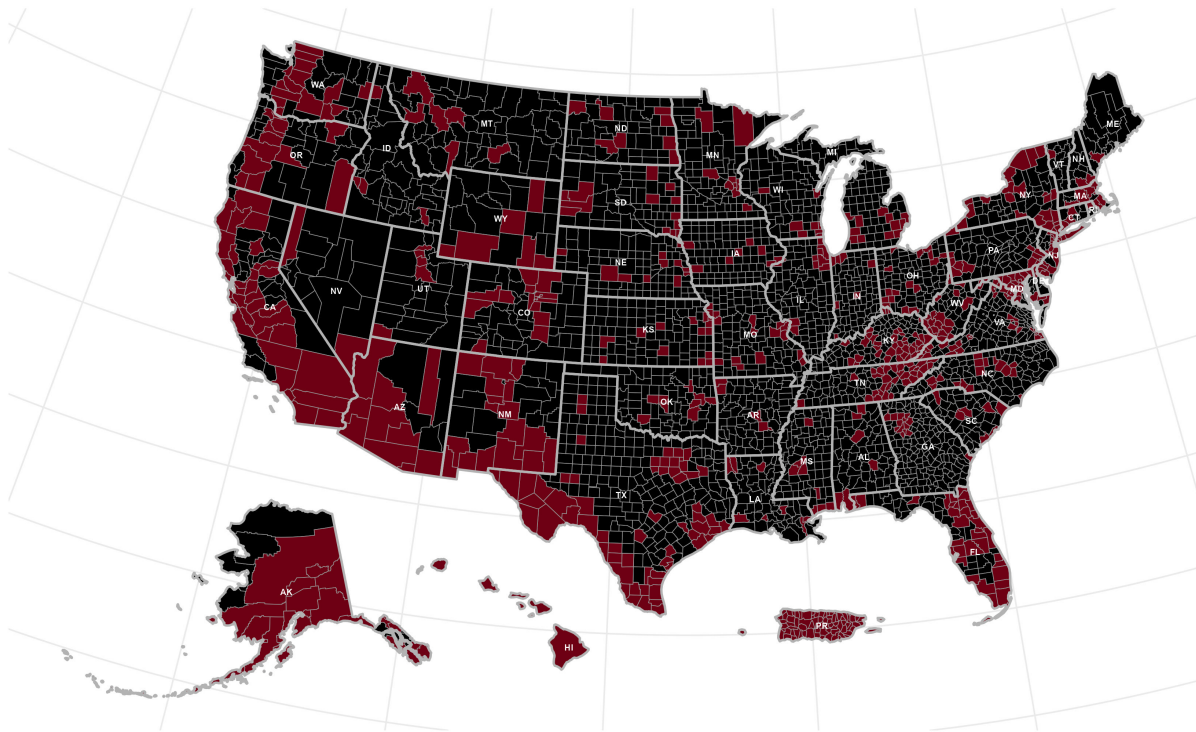
This analysis aggregates overdose death data for the five-year period from 2020 through 2024, focusing on all U.S. counties where sufficient mortality records were available for analysis. It should be noted that the final year of reporting data (2024) remains provisional and may be subject to revision as additional death certificates are processed and finalized by state vital statistics offices.

To calculate standardized overdose rates that allow for meaningful comparisons across communities of varying sizes, the average annual number of overdose deaths for each county was divided by the average population of that county over the five-year study period. This approach provides an estimated annual overdose rate per 100,000 for each community. All calculations and data processing for this project were prepared in the statistical package R<sup>2</sup> and RStudio<sup>3</sup>. The pdf document was rendered in Quarto, an open-source technical publishing system that converts plain text documents into multiple output formats including pdf<sup>4</sup>.

In accordance with standard public health data privacy protocols, overdose numbers for communities that experienced small numbers of deaths during the study period have been suppressed and are not displayed in this report. This suppression prevents potential identification of individuals in smaller communities while maintaining the statistical integrity of the analysis.

Each county is ranked from highest to lowest overdose rate to facilitate comparison with state, and national benchmarks. This ranking system enables stakeholders to quickly identify their community's relative position within their state, and in the broader national context. Counties are further classified into three categories based on their deviation from the national mean overdose rate: High, Moderate, or Low. This classification system provides an additional analytic framework for understanding the relative severity of overdose impacts across different communities and can be used to inform resource allocations and intervention prioritization decisions. Counties with a deemed "high overdose death rate" are highlighted in Red.

# HIDTA Designated Counties as of 2024



The Office of National Drug Control Policy has designated thirty-three regions across the United States as High Intensity Drug Trafficking Areas (HIDTAs). Collectively, these regions include nearly twenty-three percent of all U.S. counties, and account for roughly seventy percent of the United States population.
