COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Statistically, seventy percent (70%) of all Officer involved shootings nationally occur in “low light” or less than adequate lighting conditions for the officer. Ironically, even in the knowledge of this glaring statistic, most police training focuses on other disciplines, and avoids the reality that officers are undertrained in dealing with policing in less than ambient lighting conditions. In essence, many of us have not been taught how to use a flashlight tactically or have just been taught incorrectly. This course intends to change that metric. This class is slotted for the first 25 registrants. First come first serve.

TOPICS COVERED:

Topics will include subjects such as

1. Proper ergonomic grip of the flashlight.
2. Type of flashlight and its features.
3. Constant “on” vs using the light “intermittently.”
4. Positions of the flashlight in relation to a pistol during a search.
5. When your flashlight should be on and when it should be off.
6. Weapon mounted lights, their advantages, and disadvantages

ABOUT THE INSTRUCTORS:

Detectives Liam Swords (25+ years) and Dan Ticali (23 years) Are NY/NJ HIDTA instructors currently assigned to the NYPD's Detective Bureau Tactical Training Unit. Prior to this assignment, both worked in aggressive enforcement units within the NYPD. Both have graduated from multiple Low Light operation schools with instructor credentials, the most recent being the Centrifuge Training Low Light Instructor Course. Both gentlemen have more than 10 years in service as tactical instructors with HIDTA and the NYPD.
