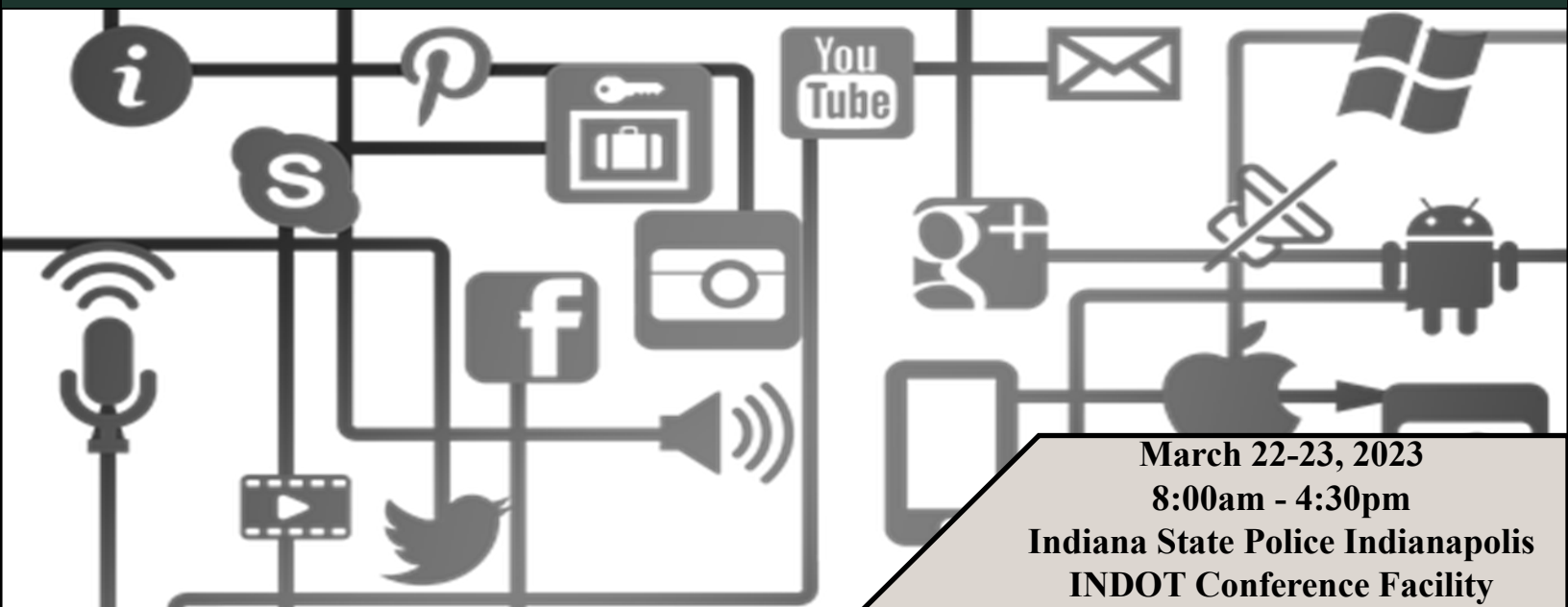


The Internet: Investigations and Intelligence
