Enhanced Tactical Medicine

This course is designed to teach Law Enforcement Officers and other first responders how to treat and manage trauma patients in a civilian tactical environment. Utilizing a mix of classroom presentation and hands-on skills training, attendees will learn how to provide life-sustaining treatments in dynamic threat conditions. Instructors will leverage military and civilian overseas and domestic experiences to illustrate and convey lessons learned. The second day includes proctored scenarios that require students to apply learned medical tactics and procedures in carefully crafted scenarios based on real world events.

Upon course completion, students will be able to identify and treat the leading causes of preventable death in a multi-phase tactical environment.
