The “SAFE in Northern Michigan” prevention program, along with the National Marijuana Initiative is pleased to announce this one-hour free virtual training session to be held on Tuesday, December 5th, 2023 at 3:30 PM eastern time. This session will look at the state of Colorado after it legalized marijuana for commercial adult use purposes in 2013 and the data / impacts that are associated to public health and public safety.

Our speaker for this session is: Mr. Dale Quigley

Dale Quigley is the Deputy Coordinator for the National Marijuana Initiative (NMI), part of the federally funded High Intensity Drug Trafficking Areas (HIDTA) program, in the United States. He offers a look back at lessons learned and potential opportunities, based in factual data collections and reporting, since Colorado legalized marijuana for the “Adult Use” marketplace in 2013. Offering fact-based information coupled with a sense of humor, you will gain insights into the evolution of marijuana in Colorado, an understanding of high potency THC and its impacts to public health and public safety.
