COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course equips law enforcement, military, corrections, and other professionals to identify, investigate, and combat human trafficking. Through classroom lessons and practical exercises, students will learn to detect trafficking, recognize victim manipulation, and understand the link between trafficking, gangs, and criminal organizations.

The course covers victim identification, interviewing techniques, the signs, symbols and tactics used by traffickers. Participants will also explore trafficking routes, online trafficking, and available resources for assisting law enforcement and victims.
