This course equips students with essential skills to geolocate images and videos using a blend of reverse image search techniques, online research methods, and visual analysis. Through a dynamic mix of interactive lectures and hands-on exercises, students will learn to identify key clues in visual media to pinpoint their geographic origins. By the end of the course, participants will be proficient in applying these techniques to enhance their investigative work, whether for journalism, research, or digital forensics.
