COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course is designed to curb the flow of narcotics with the risk and hazards presented to law enforcement, narcotics enforcement, and military members. Students will analyze verbal and nonverbal communication to identify armed and/or aggressive individuals who may or may not be under the influence of narcotics, while also diffusing the emotion of anger before violence and/or injury can occur.

This course enhances the ability of military and law enforcement personnel to recognize the indicators of violence. While also allowing them to make split-second decisions on when or when not to use force on a suspect who may appear to be a noncombatant.
