SYNOPSIS

The primary purpose of this course is to help protect responders who may encounter illicit drug manufacturing during a response. This is accomplished by providing information to help detect the presence of illicit drug manufacturing, identify hazards associated with these processes, and mitigate those hazards. The curriculum also includes PPE usage, Site Safety Plans, TTPs, and planning considerations.

While the curriculum is primarily intended for law enforcement special operations officers, personnel working in the counterdrug nexus and community-based organizations may also find the information useful during encounters with illicit drug manufacturing. Additionally, this course can be tailored to address specific illicit drug manufacturing methods and products that an organization is encountering.
