

# TARGET THE ENTIRE GANG

It takes dedication, focus, and a knowledge base of investigative techniques to eliminate the worst of the worst from your community. Any case targeting entire organizations follows the same investigative paths. The difference is what form of evidence you develop along the way, how you use it, and how you apply it towards your goal of incarcerating not just individuals but the street gang as a whole. Lead instructor, retired Detective Gerald Stanaszak served with the Milwaukee Police Department for 25 years, with 18 years in narcotics and gang investigations. During his career, Jerry participated in numerous State and Federal task forces and over 45 State and Federal wiretaps. Jerry has also served as a contract instructor for BATF over a five year period at the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center in Brunswick, GA. Instructor David Robles has served as a Milwaukee County Assistant District Attorney and as a special Assistant United States Attorney. He has worked in the Gun Unit, Gang Crimes Unit, White Collar and Organized Crime Unit. His trial experience includes over 150 criminal trials, many involving complex multi-defendant prosecutions. In 1998, Dave was one of the trial attorneys in the prosecution of 33 defendants in the Latin Kings Federal Racketeering trial. In 2005, he was one of two U.S. Attorneys who prosecuted 50 gang members in a second Latin Kings Federal RICO case. Other major gang conspiracy and drug trafficking trials include: the Julian Lopez family drug trafficking organization (13 members of this family were convicted); the Samuel Caraballo drug trafficking organization in which over 30 defendants were convicted. Presently he is prosecuting organized financial crimes and public corruption cases in his assignment in the Public Integrity Unit. The third instructor is recently retired from ATF as a Special Agent with extensive experience in wiretaps and undercover work.
