# Clan Lab Recognition & Safety (Enhanced Illicit Drug Manufacturing)

**June 11, 2026 (Thursday) Time: 0830-1700**

**Course Description:** The rising danger of illicit drug manufacturing makes this safety course essential for law enforcement, criminal analysts, and community-based partners who may encounter these hazardous sites. You will gain the critical skills to detect the presence of a lab, identify the specific chemical and physical dangers involved, and implement proven mitigation strategies to ensure your safety and the public's. With content that can be tailored to the specific drug threats your organization is facing, this course provides the vital knowledge needed to protect all responders during any counter-narcotics operation.
