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WEBINAR OVERVIEW

Record surveillance video with the phone in your pocket!

This one-hour webinar prepares investigators to record high-quality video using that camera already in their pocket: their smartphone.

Students will see the best ways to shoot surveillance video up close, while moving, and from far away using just their work cell phones. They will also learn how to attach their phones to binoculars and spotting scopes to record from extreme ranges. The class focuses on filming video that is easy to watch, keeping it completely unedited, and making sure it is safely preserved so it can be used as evidence in court.
