Instructor: Kevin Dean Radovich is a seasoned law enforcement professional with 19 years of experience in investigations, threat assessment, crisis management, and protective operations. Currently serving as a Criminal Investigator and Homeland Security Investigations (HSI) Task Force Officer with

the Putnam County Sheriff's Office, he has led complex cases involving organized crime, human trafficking, narcotics, weapons smuggling, and fraud. A certified hostage and crisis negotiator, Drug Recognition Expert (DRE) Instructor, Certified Body Language Expert, and FAA Part 107 Drone Pilot, Radovich holds a Bachelor of Arts in Forensic Psychology from John Jay College of Criminal Justice.
